

Home Heating Assistance Program 2022-2023



The home heating assistance program provides up to \$300 per household to anyone in need residing within the nine counties of the Diocese of Kalamazoo (Allegan, Barry, Berrien, Branch, Calhoun, Cass, Kalamazoo, St. Joseph, and Van Buren), which helps households defray heating expenses and obtain heating resources (fuel oil, natural gas, electricity, firewood, etc).

The program is generously funded through a special collection taken in November -- with funds contributed from more than 50 parishes and missions across the Diocese of Kalamazoo. The parishes/missions may keep 20% of the funds collected for local use, serving the poor and vulnerable. The remaining 80% is contributed to the program and given out to families in need.

In 2021-2022, we aided 270 households in our community, impacting over 700 individuals.
