Housing programs within the agency affirmatively market housing options and work with individuals to help them identify their housing needs and barriers, then help them to develop a plan to resolve those barriers and meet those needs.

- All individuals who are placed in housing or assisted with housing by Catholic Family Services are given the most recent copy of "[Fair Housing: Equal Opportunity for All](#)" to review and are provided clarification and assistance as needed to ensure they understand their housing rights.

- All applicants for housing are considered based on qualifications -- no applicant or contractor will be denied housing or a contract based on their race, color, national origin, religion, age, sex, marital status, familial status, and/or handicap.
